

Cool Things to Add to Your Webpage

Animation Graphics

You can find free Clipart Animations on thousands of websites. You can Google search for them.

There is a two step process for placing an animation on your web page.

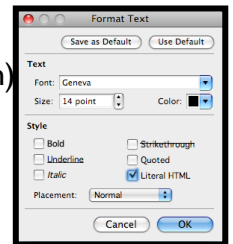
1. CONTROL - CLICK the image and a pop-up menu will appear.
2. Choose "Save Linked File to Desktop", which will cause the actual animation file to appear on the desktop of your laptop computer.
3. You can then drag the file to a specific place on any Rapid Web Designer page.
4. The animation will not work until you preview it on a web page.

Web Tracker

You can find free Web Trackers on thousands of websites. You can Google search for them.

Here is the basic process:

1. Go find a web tracker web site that has a tracker that you like.
2. Follow the instructions and input any data they may ask for about your webpage.
3. There will be an HTML code that you will need to get. Sometimes it is right there, other times they email it to you.
4. Copy the HTML code to your clipboard.
5. Go to your RWD page that you wish to place the web tracker on.
6. Paste the code where you want it to appear on the page. (top or bottom)
7. Highlight the code.
8. Click on Format>Format Text...> and be sure to select "Literal HTML"



Adding You Tube Clips

You can find billions of You Tube Clips. You can search for ones that have educational value for your class.

1. Search for a You Tube clip. Find one that you like.
2. After you preview it and determine that it is appropriate for class. Check to see if you can access it. To the right of the page on You Tube, you will see a window like this:
3. Click on the Embed window. That is an HTML code that plays the movie. After clicking, it should turn blue.
4. Copy it to the clip board.
5. Go to your RWD page that you wish to place the clip on.
6. Paste the code where you want it to appear on the page.
7. Highlight the code.
8. Click on Format>Format Text...> and be sure to select "literal HTML"
