Video Converter & DVD Uploader

*Did you ever want to Insert You Tube clips to a PowerPoint
or save them onto DVD?*

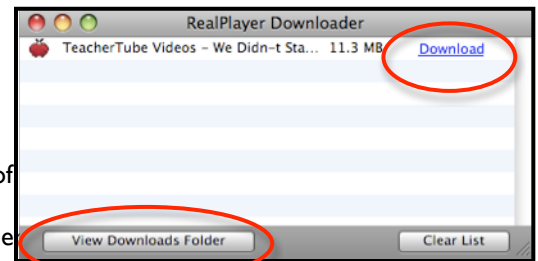
First, many of you might already have Real Player on your computer. Check to see. Even if you do, be sure you have the latest version. The more recent versions of Real Player comes with Real Player Downloader. This is a program that captures the history of all the video clips you view on the Internet.



When you view a video clip, your Real Player Downloader will show you how many clips you have previewed. When you click on the icon, you will be able to view it again, or download it to your Downloads folder. Once a video clip is in your downloads folder, you can fetch it with Handbrake to convert it to something useable (PowerPoint, iDVD, iTunes, etc) on your MacBook computer.

Video Conversion

1. Download a free version of Handbrake from the Internet.
2. Try this link: <http://handbrake.fr/?article=download>
3. Search for a video on the Internet. You Tube has million of clips...some of
4. After you preview a clip that you like, click on your Real Player Downloader Download button.
5. You can view the contents of your folder by clicking on the button in the lower left.
6. Once you open your Real Player Downloads Folder, you will notice that each downloaded file has an .flv extension. Mac programs and .flv are not compatible with each other. Therefore, you will need to convert the file to something else. (.mp4, m4v & .mov are compatible with Mac programs)



7. Open Handbrake. Click on the Source button. Browse your computer to find the clip in your Real Player Downloads Folder, or where ever you saved your file. Once you have located it, click on Add to Queue. The click on Show Queue. Press the Start button to begin conversion. Handbrake will let you know when it is complete!
8. If you are interested in uploading DVD's to your computer to view on your iPod or iPod-Touch, the process is the same. The only difference is finding the source. In this procedure, when finding your source, you will click on your DVD icon after you have inserted your disc.
