Did you ever want to Insert You Tube clips to a PowerPoint or save them onto DVD?

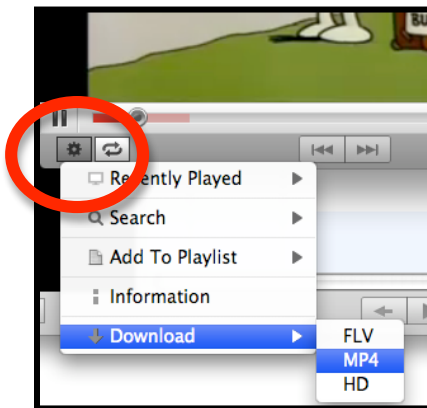
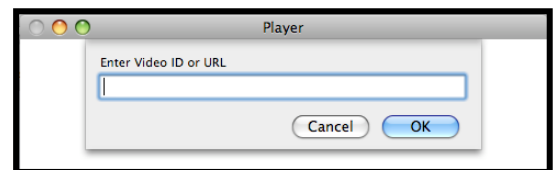
You need to first download the free Mac Tubes software from:

1. Go to You Tube and find a clip of interest.
2. Copy the URL address
 - a. press command + L to highlight the address window
 - b. press command +C to copy address to clipboard

3. Open the application: Mac Tubes.
4. Go to File > Open Video...
5. Put your cursor in the window and press command + V to paste the URL address from your clip board. And click OK



6. Once the video completely loads, click on the gear button in the lower left corner.
7. Select Download. Then choose the conversion you would prefer to use. I like MP4 because it can then be played in Quick Time or iTunes.
8. Check to see the location of where the video clip saves. (I normally like to save it to my desktop, so that I can direct it to a specific spot later or delete it when I am done.)

9. Now that you have the clip on your desktop, you can insert it into a PowerPoint presentation. To do so, open your presentation to the slide you wish to insert the clip to. Click on the INSERT pull-down menu and select Movie...
10. Browse and select the clip you converted.

11. By using iDVD, you can make a hard-copy of your video clips by burning them to disc.
