



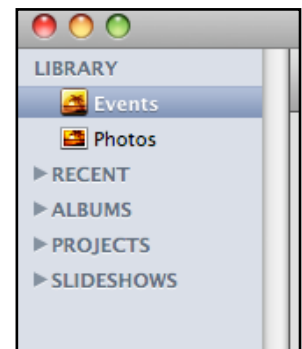

Importing Digital Camera Pictures & Organizing Your Digital Images

1. Plug in your digital camera with a USB cable.
2. IPhoto will automatically import selected pictures.
3. IPhoto will organize your images as events. This is a nice way to help your organize your photos for future use.
4. Each time you import new photos, iPhoto will create a new event for you. In your "Events" gallery, you can view all the photos from each event. Simply drag your mouse across the thumbnail to view all pictures. Or double click on the event to display all the photos.

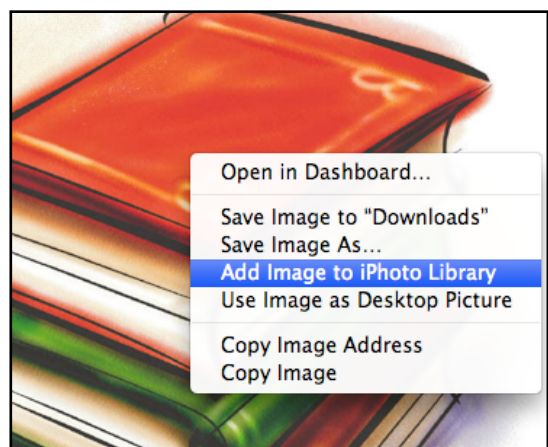
1. You can also organize your photos by creating a photo album. This allows you to combine pictures from various events in any order you wish.
2. You don't have to create albums for all your pictures. The best time to create an album is when you wish to create a project. Some projects may be slideshows, book, calendar, etc.
3. After you create a new album. It will appear in the **source list**. Click on the library to view all photos from your collection. Find the pictures you want, click and drag them over to the new album.



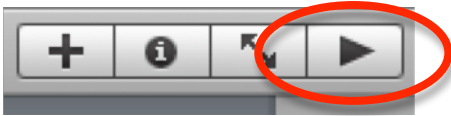
Organizing Your Internet Pics

If you find a picture on the web that you'd like to keep, save/organize them in your Events Library – It's easy!!

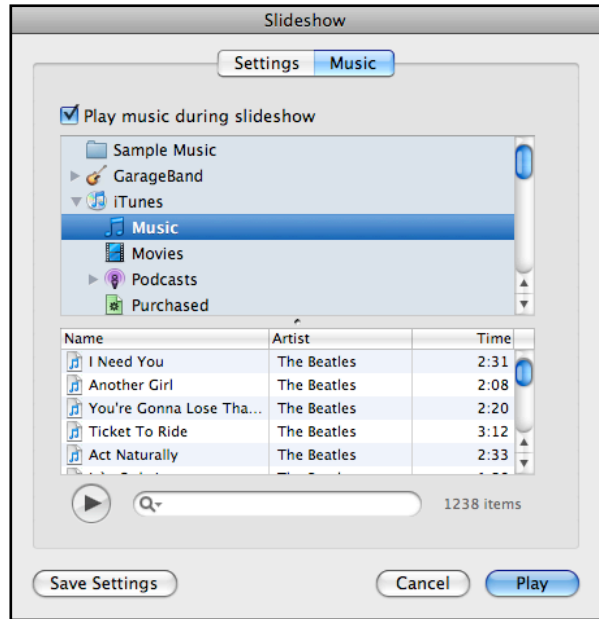
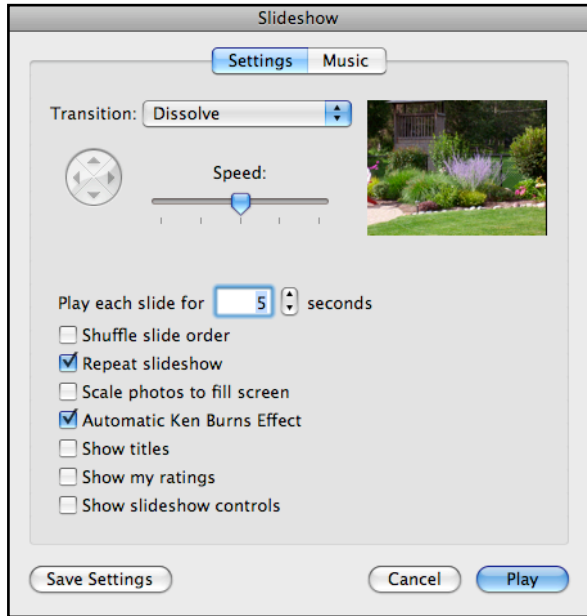
1. If you are using Safari as your web browser, when you find an image that you like, ctrl+click and a pop-up window has a default choice for you to add the image to your iPhoto library!!
2. If you are using Fire Fox, ctrl+click the image and save it to the desktop. You must drag the file into iPhoto manually.
3. Once you are back in iPhoto, you can drop the added pic to an event using the Click, Drag & Drop skill. The Mac will ask you if you want to merge the events, click yes.



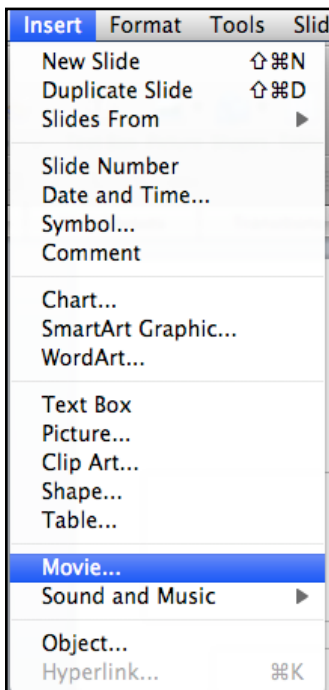
You can make a slideshow of your pictures in just a few clicks.



1. Create a new photo album and drag the pictures you want to add to the album. Then press the play button in the bottom left corner.
2. By clicking the play button, you can choose some viewing options as shown below. Also, you can click on the music button and have your favorite songs from your iTunes play automatically.



Covert your slideshows into movies that you can add to PowerPoint presentations or webpage.



1. Make a slideshow as shown in the steps above.
2. Click on File in the pull-down menu and select Export...
3. Choose Quicktime and then click Export.
4. Save the file to a location of your choice.
5. It will save with a “.mov” extension.
6. To insert the movie into PowerPoint, create a new presentation or open an existing file.
7. Go to the Insert pull-down menu, select Movie...
8. Find the movie from it's saved location.
9. Done!!
